The Practice acts as a teaching site for students at the University of Bristol. Working in the community is an important part of their medical education. We take 4th year students on a four-week placement to broaden their experience in primary care and help them to develop the skills necessary to complete their undergraduate medical training.

When you book an appointment, we will advise you if a student is likely to be present during your consultation.

We are also delighted to announce that Pembroke Road is now a Training Practice. This means that we will have Junior Doctors undergoing their post-graduate training, working here at the surgery. They are fully qualified doctors and can see you for any problem. We are all very excited about this new development and are certain it will bring great benefits to the surgery and our patients.

Research

Pembroke Road Surgery is committed to research and gets involved in studies organised by the *Primary Care Research Network* (PCRN) and the *National Institute for Health Research* (NIHR). All research studies have been approved by a local NHS Research Ethics Committee. Our involvement in research assists the development of the evidence base used to inform the prevention, diagnosis and management of illness in primary care. Pembroke Road helps researchers recruit patients into high quality studies adopted by PCRN. Patients would never be involved in a research project without their permission, nor would personal information be disclosed without the patient's consent.
